FAQ's

- Is there a late stay option? Yes there is. It will be a £5 charge and you must inform a flourish staff member at drop off. It will run for an hour after advertised pick-up (e.g 3.30pm finish = 3.30-4.30pm late stay)
- What will my child need to bring? For any day/week long camp, the small kit list is on the consent form which will need to be completed and signed before attendance. For tutoring sessions, they will just need a pencil/pen as all resources are provided (we of course have spare writing equipment if needed).
- Are activities risk assessed? Yes absolutely. We take a great deal of care and attention in making sure all activities and areas visited are risk assessed. Every member of flourish staff is briefed and compliant with our risk assessments and policies.
- Will I need to fill in a consent form for Tuition sessions as well as day/week long camps? Yes please. You will just need to update us if any information changes. We may occasionally go out and about at The Farm to enjoy more practical sessions. This will give participants chance to see specific subject areas in a real-life setting (e.g maths measuring could be a small practical session outside)
- Can a parent/Guardian stay for the shorter session (such as tutoring)? You can certainly stay onsite by all means and enjoy the Farm shop and Café. Being with the group is unfortunately not possible due to DBS regulations.
- Are all staff DBS Checked? Yes!
- Can my child purchase anything from the Farm shop or café whilst attending a camp? Yes they can, but they will have to wait until a camp leader can take them (unless they are accompanied by a parent or guardian). Please remember any money they bring will be their responsibility and not that of Flourish at The Farm staff.
- Will my child come into contact with members of the public? Yes in certain instances as it's a public place, however, children will always be accompanied by a member of Flourish staff. *The*

- education areas are very much reserved for the children so these will not be open to the public.
- Can my child bring electronic equipment? We highly recommend they don't as we do not want them to get lost or broken. If you allow your child to bring electronics with them, then Flourish at The Farm and The Farm itself will take no responsibility for any loss or damage.
- Can my child have a mobile phone with them? As above but we unfortunately have a to say no photos and social media access whist children are in our care. Thank you for understanding as we aim to protect every child to the best of our ability.
